Prefacio

Encanto de Invierno: Melodías fáciles para piano en la temporada fría ha sido cuidadosamente compilado para capturar la atmósfera clara, tranquila y mágica del invierno en piezas de piano accesibles. Las obras de esta colección han sido simplificadas y reducidas a su esencia, permitiéndote sumergirte directamente en las melodías sin necesidad de practicar extensamente. Esta edición está dirigida tanto a principiantes como a pianistas avanzados que deseen disfrutar del ambiente invernal a través de clásicos fáciles de tocar.

La colección comienza con *El Invierno – Largo* (RV 297) de Antonio Vivaldi, una pieza cuya melodía serena y fluida evoca la tranquila quietud de una nevada invernal. Le sigue *Enero – Junto a la chimenea* (Op. 37a No. 1) de Piotr Ilich Tchaikovsky, una composición cálida que refleja la acogedora calidez de una chimenea crepitante.

El tiempo de invierno I (Op. 68 No. 38) de Robert Schumann recrea la calma contemplativa de un paseo invernal. En su forma simplificada, esta pieza es una joya poética que captura el frío puro y la magia del invierno. Igualmente fascinante es *La nieve baila* (L. 113 No. 4) de Claude Debussy, que evoca la ligereza de los copos de nieve cayendo con sus tonos delicados y danzantes.

La colección concluye con *Noche de Paz* en un arreglo de Carl Reinecke. Este villancico navideño atemporal, presentado en una versión simplificada pero expresiva, irradia calidez festiva y es perfecto para compartir el espíritu invernal con familiares y amigos.

Esta colección te invita a experimentar la magia del invierno en el piano con un esfuerzo mínimo. Las piezas están arregladas para que puedas preparar rápidamente un programa de concierto invernal para presentar a tu audiencia. Ofrecen no solo placer al tocar, sino también una entrada fácil al mundo de los clásicos fáciles.
