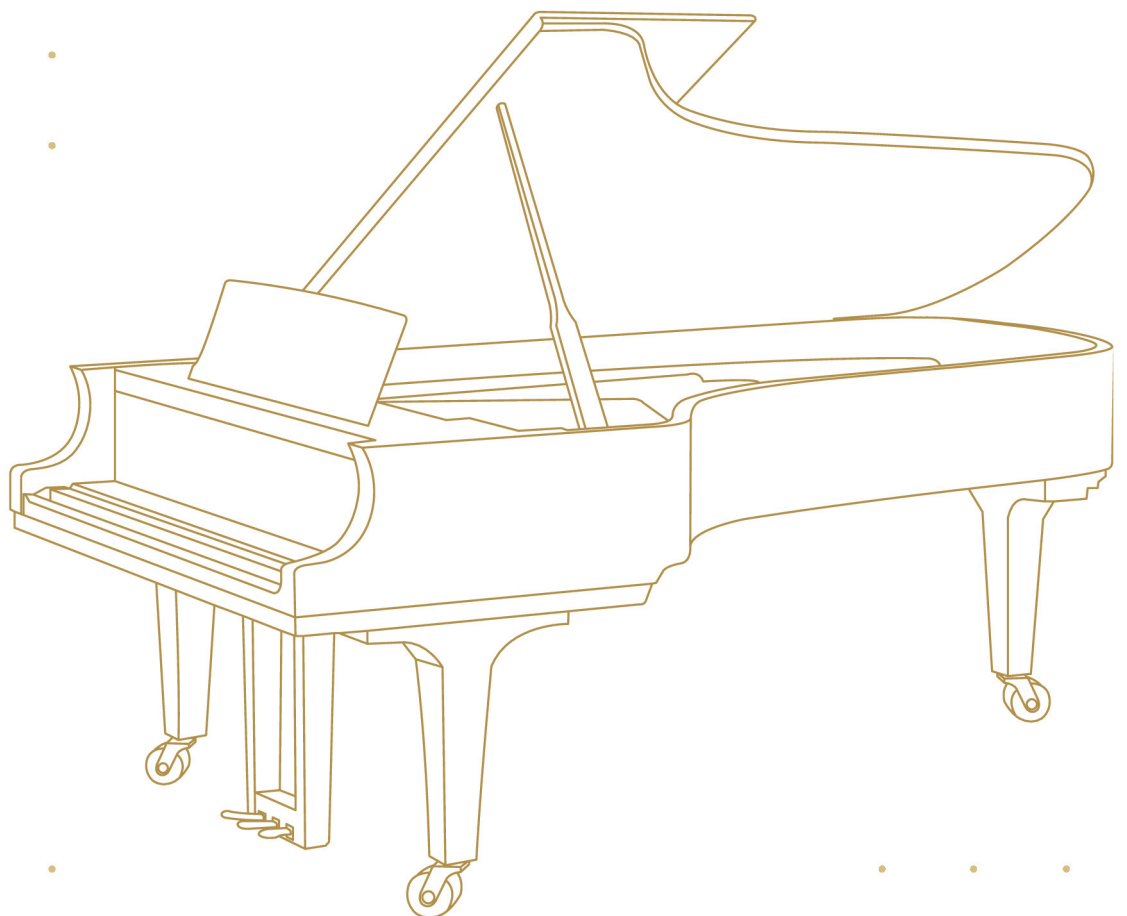

Jigg, HWV 437
